

<u>Small Paws – Big Hearts</u>

I understand the dog I am adopting today does have an imperfection. Modog's imperfection is as told to Tiny Paws by the facility the dog was received from.
I understand that small puppies tend to have common puppy ailments sucl as Giardia, Coccidia, worms, Kennel Cough, and that Tiny Paws has done their bes to prevent and or treat any and all ailments this pup may or may not have had.
I understand that these pups are under stress when put into a new situation new homes, and it is very common in the first 2 weeks for them to break out with common ailments, even if properly treated. I may need to watch for these ailments and take them to the vet at the first sign of any ailments, and to notification.
I understand that if my pup is of very little size, I will have extra responsibility in watching any and all food and water intake and have educated myself in the amount of food and water my pup is required to have daily. (If a 3 pound pupped does not eat or drink for 12 hours this IS AN EMERGENCY!)
I understand that even though pups are vaccinated, they are only partially protected and may still develop diseases such as Distemper or Parvovirus and that Tiny Paws has done all they can to prevent this from occurring. Should the pupshow signs of these illnesses, I understand it is my responsibility to take him/her to the vet and cover the cost of treatment, and to notify Tiny Paws.
